

CONSTITUTION OF THE MID MICHIGAN MODERN MUSCLE CAR CLUB, INC.

A NON-PROFIT MICHIGAN DOMESTIC CORPORATION

Article I. NAME The name of this organization shall be The Mid Michigan Modern Muscle Car Club, hereinafter referred to as the Club.

Article II. PURPOSE

- A.** The Club was founded by a small group of modern muscle car enthusiasts who were looking to form a member friendly club. The Club is an all volunteer, non-profit organization.
- B.** The purpose of the Club is to promote interest in the ownership and operation of modern muscle cars, to educate the general public on what a modern muscle car is, to encourage organized activities and events around the ownership and enjoyment of modern muscle cars, and to provide a shared place of knowledge in the operation, care, and modification of modern muscle cars.
- C.** The Club will hold regular monthly meetings, social, competitive and other types of events in order that the Club purpose can be fulfilled .

Article III. MEMBERSHIP

- A.** Membership shall be open to all owners of modern muscle cars as defined by the Club board of directors and who meet the requirements for membership as set forth in the By-Laws of the Club. Each member in good standing shall be known as the General Membership.

Article IV. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. OFFICERS.** The officers of the Club in order of succession are : President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and General Board Member. The board of directors shall conduct all business and activities of the Club.
- B. TERM.** Above stated officers hold a lifetime position. If an officer of the Club resigns his or her position it shall be done so in writing 30 days prior to resignation of duties. If at any time a vacancy arises in the board of directors, the position may be filled by an active club member in good standing upon their nomination by another active member and a vote to be conducted of all members in good standing.

- C. DIRECTORS.** A Board of Directors shall be established to be made up of the following 5 members: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and General Board Member. The Board of Directors shall conduct all the business and activities of the Club. They are governed by the rules and laws set forth in this Constitution and/ or the By-Laws of the Club.

Article V. MEETINGS

- A. TYPES OF MEETINGS.** The types of meetings shall be : Board of Directors, General Membership, and Emergency. All meetings are to be held in accordance with the rules set forth in this Constitution and the By-Laws of the Club.

Article VI. CLUB INSIGNIA AND COLORS

- A. CLUB INSIGNIA.** The Club insignia is to be considered the Corporate Seal of the Club. It shall be the exclusive property of the Club and it's members. No individual, club, business, or corporation may display the Club insignia without the express written consent of the Club. Further, no individual, club, business, corporation, no any member may use or display the Club insignia in such a manner as to be defamatory or in any other way harmful to the Club or its members.

- B. COLORS.** The official colors of the Club shall be Red, White, Black, and Blue.

Article VII. AMENDMENTS

A. Amendments to this Constitution can be made in the following manner:

- 1.** Any five members in good standing can submit a written copy of the proposed amendment to the Club Secretary.
- 2.** The Secretary will then read the proposed amendment at the next Board of Directors meeting.
- 3.** Discussion will be held at this time and a vote by the Board of Directors will follow.
- 4.** The passage of proposed amendment requires a majority vote of the Board of Directors with all Board Members present.
- 5.** If an amendment is passed, a copy of said amendment will be mailed or E-mailed to the home of each member in good standing.
